Gaming Control Board Reports Total Revenue Up 4.5% In Calendar Year 2019

Statewide revenue for gaming and fantasy contests totaled over \$3.4 billion in 2019

HARRISBURG, PA: Figures released today by the Pennsylvania Gaming Control Board shows total gaming and fantasy contests revenue generated in the Commonwealth during calendar year 2019 was 4.5% above revenue generated in calendar year 2018.

Sources of gaming revenue regulated by the Board include slot machines, table games, internet gaming, retail and internet sports







Subject: Telehealth Services for Gambling Treatment

On March 6, 2020, pursuant to the provisions of Subsection 7301(c) of the Emergency Management Services Code, 35 Pa. C.S. § 7101, et seq., Governor Tom Wolf issued a Proclamation of Disaster Emergency related to the novel Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19).

During the term of this Disaster Emergency, providers who have a grant agreement with the Department of Drug and Alcohol Programs to provide outpatient problem gambling services may use grant funds to provide assessments and outpatient counseling for clients using telehealth technology.

Counselors who have grant agreements are able to provide telehealth using real-time, two-way interactive audio-video transmission services in the office setting. While the two-way interactive transmission is the preferred method, services provided by telephone and in the home are also acceptable.

All federal and state privacy and confidentiality requirements applicable to in person services remain



as Kickoff to Problem Gambling Awareness Month



As part of the agency's efforts to raise awareness of problem and compulsive gambling and provide both professionals and individuals with information, the PGCB has launched an updated user-friendly website that provides information on how to recognize the warning signs of a gambling problem and to find treatment options that are available in Pennsylvania.


Elizabeth Lanza, Director of the PGCB's Office of Compulsive and Problem Gambling says that while the agency recognizes that most individuals can gamble in a safe, responsible manner, not all are able to control their gambling behavior.
